

How to configure the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite for the P900

The Sony-Ericsson P900 phone ships with a specifically designed version of PC Suite. This can be used with TDK Systems USB Adapter and PC Card devices.

About this Guide

There are several steps you'll need to take to use the Nokia PC Suite, we recommend that you only undertake them if you feel confident installing software applications and making configuration settings.

WARNING! This guide is not very long! But if you follow it concisely we are confident you will get it all working smoothly.


PLEASE FOLLOW THIS GUIDE CAREFULLY AND CONCISELY – if there are statements in **RED** as above please take care and do exactly as advised.

ADVICE IN THIS GOLD COLOUR is also valuable - it will save you from encountering problem areas in subsequent steps; please pay attention to it too.

Important Note: At this time, Sony-Ericsson PC Suite is not compatible with Windows 98 or 98SE operating systems.






Getting connected with Bluetooth

To get the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite to connect to the Sony-Ericsson P900, you need to connect to the Bluetooth serial port of the P900. Once the P900 has the Bluetooth address of your TDK Systems USB Adapter or PC Card, it will drop the current connection and then re-connect. Only after this re-connection will the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite for the P900 work.

Start		Ensure your TDK Bluetooth USB Adaptor or PC card is installed on your computer
Step 1		Install the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite on your computer. You should now see a new icon in your system tray
Advice:	All users	You should have paired your Sony-Ericsson phone to your PC. If you have not done this, use the TDK Sony Ericsson P900 Assistant (part of the latest TDK Bluetooth software). Start it by right-clicking the Bluetooth icon in your system tray and selecting Applications .






<p>Step 2</p>		<p>Right-click the Bluetooth icon in your system tray, select Setup, Configuration, then click the Local Services tab. If you do not have the Setup option, choose Advanced Configuration and then click the Local Services tab.</p> <p>Under the column Service Name, you will see Bluetooth Serial Port listed. This will have a COM Port assigned to it. Note the COM Port number the Bluetooth Serial Port is using. For example: COM4.</p>						
<p>Step 3</p>		<p>Next, right-click the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite tray icon (mRouter) and select Properties</p>

<p>Advice: Step 5</p>	<p>All Users</p>	<p>During the next few steps you may be asked to accept connection requests on the phone and on the PC. This is safe, and necessary for the installation.</p>						
<p>Step 6</p>		<p>From My Bluetooth Places find your Sony-Ericsson phone and double click on the Serial Port icon. Only if you have successfully paired with the Sony-Ericsson phone you will be able to do this.</p>						
<p>Step 7</p>	<p>You will get a dialog box saying your serial service is connected to COM0, tick the box and Click OK.</p>  <p>Bluetooth Serial Port</p> <p>The Bluetooth serial port COM0 is now configured to connect to the device</p> <p>The Application that will use this connection must be configured to use COM0.</p> <p>The application may be started at any time.</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Do not display this message again</p> <p>OK</p>

<p>Step 8</p>	<p>You will now see a disconnect notice saying that the remote device closed the connection. This is normal. Click OK.</p> 	
<p>Step 9</p>	<p>Next you will see the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite icon change from  to  as the Sony-Ericsson phone connects back to the PC</p>	
<p><i>Advice:</i></p>	<p>The dialog box shown in Step 4 should now look like this:</p> 	
<p>Step 10</p>		<p>Now you can open the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite Software from task bar icon</p>
<p><i>Advice:</i></p>	<p>All users</p>	<p>When you connect for the first time the PC Suite runs a set up Wizard. Follow the on screen instructions to set up your Synchronisation options between your PC and your phone.</p>

Disconnecting & reconnecting PC Suite

When you have finished using PC Suite you will have to manually disconnect.

<p>Step 11</p>		<p>When you have finished, exit PC Suite</p>
<p>Step 12</p>		<p>Go to My Bluetooth Places</p>
<p>Step 13</p>		<p>Double click on My Device</p>
<p><i>Advice: Step 13</i></p>	<p>XP Users</p>	<p>XP users should click on View My Bluetooth Services for Step 13.</p>
<p>Step 14</p>		<p>Right click on My Bluetooth Serial Port or Bluetooth Serial Port then click on Stop or Disable</p>
<p>Step 15</p>	<p>Before you finish, right click again on My Bluetooth Serial Port or Bluetooth Serial Port then click on Start or Enable. This allows future sessions with the Sony-Ericsson PC Suite to work correctly</p>	
<p><i>Advice:</i></p>	<p>An alternative way to do this is to turn off the phone! When you turn it on again the Bluetooth connection will have been broken.</p>	
<p>Step 16</p>	<p>Follow the above procedure from Step 6</p>

Easy Life 3		Open a business card; click on the Contacts menu, select Send as , followed by Bluetooth from the options list. Lastly select your PC from the discovered Bluetooth devices
Easy Life 3		Open a Calendar item, click on the Calendar menu, and select Send as , followed by Bluetooth from the options list. Lastly select your PC from the discovered Bluetooth devices
Easy Life 3		Open a picture, click on the Picture menu, and select Send as , followed by Bluetooth from the options list. Lastly select your PC from the discovered Bluetooth devices
